## Te Anau - Luxmore Jet

Your exhilarating one hour jetboat ride, includes stops at 3 actual film locations where Frodo & the Fellowship paddled their Elven boats down the River Anduin (Upper Waiu River). There's plenty of time to take photos before continuing on to the breathtaking beauty of Lake Manapouri, often referred to as "the loveliest of all New Zealand's many lakes" before returning to Queen's Reach & your courtesy transfer back to Te Anau. **Duration:** 1 hr in boat, allow 90 min. including accommodation transfers.

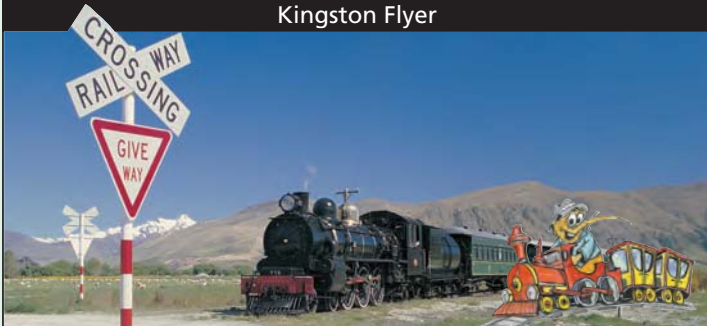


## Milford Sound - The Big Day Out

Departing Te Anau, this full day trip has it all – coach, cruise & walk about. Utilising small coaches, this excursion to Milford Sound is unique in that guests are given the option of (A) a 2.5 hr (unguided) stunning walk through lush beech rainforest on the famous Routeburn track to magnificent Key Summit. Or (B) stay with the coach and your guide & explore the Lower Hollyford Valley with short nature walks & a visit to Gunns Camp & Museum & other scenic highlights. Groups A & B then reunite for a tea break enroute to a leisurely 2.5 hr Nature Cruise on Milford Sound. **Departs** 8am, returns 6.30pm Oct to April.

## Kingston Flyer



The Kingston Flyer is the nickname of a vintage steamtrain, located on the southern shores of Lake Wakatipu, a 40 minute drive south from Queenstown. The Kingston Flyer's history spans over 120 years & still provides daily departures (Oct-Apr) from Kingston Station to Fairlight at 10am & 1.30pm. Duration 30 mins. one way, 90 mins. return. Indulge in the luxury of a bygone era: let yourself be carried back to the late 1800's, a time of gold, steam earth & dreams. The Kingston Flyer is also available for private charters all year.

## Full Day Milford Sound Kayaking

This is as about as close to communing with nature as you can get! After being collected from your accommodation, learn about the history, landmarks & conservation issues enroute to majestic Milford Sound. On arrival get ready for 4 hours of spectacular kayaking. Highlights include dramatic sheer cliffs, classic Mitre Peak, waterfalls, enormous glacier carved valleys and possibly friendly fur seals or playful dolphins. For lunch we aim to stop on a beach beneath the majestic mountains. Bring your own lunch or order from us (\$17). On the journey home we have allowed time for scenic stops, short walks, good NZ music & some well earned rest time. **Note:** If bad weather prevents kayaking it is replaced by a launch cruise & extended nature tour. Includes a professional sea kayaking guide, all kayaking clothing, safety gear & instruction, plus morning & afternoon tea. **Departs** Te Anau 6.30am, returns 6pm. Min. age 16 yrs.

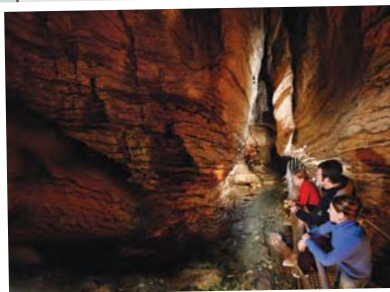
## Fiordland Region - Hump Ridge Jet

Come & discover NZ's last frontier, the south of Fiordland National Park. Home to NZ's deepest lake & steepest (boatable) river, the Wairaurahiri (betcha can't pronounce that!) plus truly awesome scenery. This is undoubtedly NZ's best jet boat ride & one trip you don't want to miss! Travel 27 kms along grade 3 white-water rapids strewn with huge boulders which lead you to the wild south coast, the last place in NZ to lose the sun each day. There is time to walk to see the mighty Percy Burn Viaduct or take a nature walk into NZ's largest & oldest podocarp forest. This full day trip departs on demand from Otautau, Tuatapere or Lake Hauroko (117 kms south of Te Anau). Min numbers apply. Packed lunch available at NZ\$15 p.p. or delicious BBQ option NZ\$20 p.p. All safety and wet weather gear provided.
