



Bay of Islands Fishing Charter

The Bay of Islands has a world wide reputation for excellent salt water fishing with a range of species available, including Yellowtail Kingfish, Snapper & Shark which can be targeted all year round. For a real adrenaline rush, targeting Kingfish comes highly recommended. No fishing licence required. All fishing equipment and bait included, along with tea & coffee. We suggest taking along your own refreshments & food as required. Unless a sole charter has been organised, guests will be allocated to the most appropriate fishing party on the day.



Options include:

Bottom/Snapper Fishing – 4 hours. Morning or Afternoon trips **\$140 p.p.**
Share charter targeting Kingfish & Reef fish

(min 4 people) – 6 hrs **\$304 p.p.**

Sole Charter targeting Kingfish & Reef fish

(1-4 people) – 6 hours **\$1171** 8 hours **\$1532**

Share Charter Marlin/Tuna & Shark – Full Day **\$507 p.p.**

Salt Air - Bay of Islands Scenic Flights

Salt Air provides very personalised tours for those who wish to experience Northland in its entirety, much of which is only accessible by air. Tours depart regularly and include transfers to and from Kerikeri Airport for the half day tour. Minimum 2 passengers.



Helicopter Hole in the Rock Flight - Experience the wonderful view of the Bay of Islands including the famous "Hole in the Rock" via helicopter – a thrilling experience over NZ's favourite maritime playground. **Departures** directly from Paihia waterfront regularly.

Return flight down the East Coast introduces you to areas impossible to see any other way. **Departures** morning and afternoon. Tour duration approx. 5 hours.

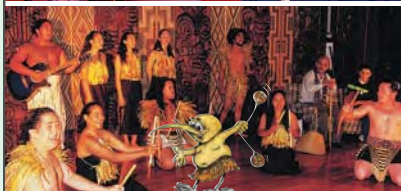
